STUDENT	DOB
If needed for a prolonged or cluster seizure, Diastat will be administered to a student per the written orders of the student's physician.	
Diastat will be administered by the school nurse or other school personnel who have received training on the procedure for giving this medication.	
If Diastat is administered, 911 will be called immediately. When Diastat is given, close monitoring of the student's respiratory status and seizure activity is necessary. Once Paramedics arrive, they will determine if the student needs transporting to the nearest children's hospital or if the parents can monitor the child at home. If parents are not on site at the school the student will be transported to the hospital.
